











How to Make Homemade Candles

Materials Needed

Select One from Each Row

Container	 CERAMIC	 TIN	 Jar GLASS	
Wick	 PRE-WAXED WIRE	 WOOD WICKS		
Wax	 PARAFFIN WAX	 PALM OIL	 BEESWAX	 SOY
Scent	 SCENTED WAX CUBES		 ESSENTIAL OILS	

Making Candles

Results May Vary

STEP 1



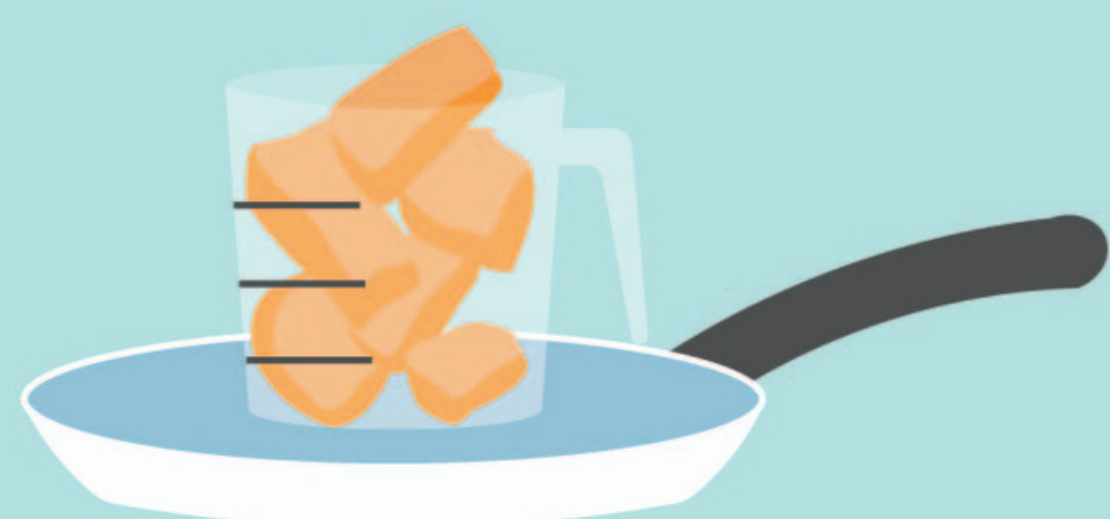
Take a small drop of wax to adhere the wick of your choice to the bottom of your container.

STEP 2



If you are using the pre-waxed wire, wrap the wire around a pencil to keep steady for the wax.

STEP 3



Place your wax in a measuring cup. Fill your pan with 2 inches of water and begin melting your wax.

STEP 4



Pour the melted wax into the container. Wait 24 hours for the wax to dry completely.
