

HOW TO SEW A PATCH



1. Gather materials: scissors, needles, thread, pin, patch and measuring tape. Wash, dry, and iron fabric if needed.



2. Measure and set patch onto desired location. You can mark it but that is optional.



3. Pin patch to hold. Make sure that your patch will not move.



4. Thread needle with matching thread and knot the end.



5. Hold patch and push threaded needle through fabric and patch from the back, about 1/8-inch from edge.



6. Slowly sew around the patch using a running or straight stitch. Remove pin after one side is stitched.



7. Finish stitching around patch. Knot and trim excess thread on back once patch is completely sewn.
